Sequins or glitter or both

An apron might be needed 😊

A jug of cold water

Cooking oil

Food colouring

Brown or white vinegar

Bicarbonate of Soda

A Christmas decoration – something like a snowman or Father Christmas

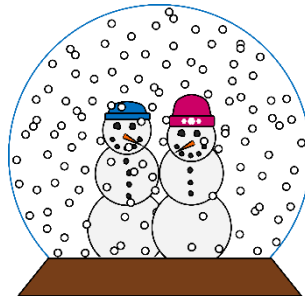
Spoon
